



Air Quality Competition

The University of Canterbury, the New Zealand branch of the Clean Air Society of Australia and New Zealand, and the New Zealand Transport Agency are pleased to announce a poster competition for Year 12 students in Canterbury studying Geography.

Students are invited to submit a poster around the subject of **air quality**. This can be based on **any** part of the curriculum including:

- AS 90336 Explain a contemporary geographic issue and evaluate courses of action, or
- US 5092 Explain a current geographic issue.

Prizes of Westfield vouchers, generously funded by the New Zealand Transport Agency, will be awarded as follows:

- 1st prize: \$500
- 2nd prize: \$300
- 3rd prize: \$200

The two top posters will be displayed at the 20th International Clean Air and Environment Conference, which will be held in Auckland from 31st July to 2nd August 2011 (transferred from its original venue in Christchurch).

The winning students will be invited to attend the afternoon session on Sunday 31st July to present their poster, meet delegates, answer questions about their entries and receive their awards (all travel costs and one night's accommodation will be met by the conference).

Competitors are encouraged to also enter their work in the Canterbury-Westland Science Fair later in the year (www.canterburysciencefair.co.nz/welcome/index)

Entries should be A1 in size (594 × 841mm) and should be sent to UC Science Outreach to arrive no later than 5pm **Friday 17th June**. Electronic versions may be submitted by email but will be printed at A1 size for display, so must have a suitably high resolution.
